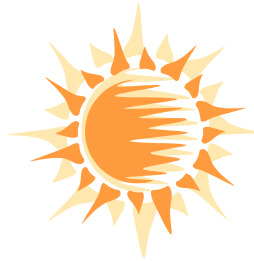

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

August is Camp Meeting Month

Deb Dougherty will sing on August 7th, Eddie Bines on August, 14, "Cornerstone" from Cornerstone Baptist Church on August 21st and "None of the Above" will sing on August 28th. The last Sunday of the month is Homecoming and Rev. Glenn Griffith, who is now retired and lives in Winston-Salem, will be preaching. You are reminded that on August 28, Homecoming Sunday, we will wear old time clothes. We will **NOT HAVE SUNDAY SCHOOL AND THE WORSHIP SERVICE WILL BEGIN AT 10:00 AM.** There will be a covered dish luncheon after the preaching service so please bring a covered dish.

The tradition of Camp Meeting goes back to the days of the development of Christianity in the American Colonies. Circuit riding preachers of all denominations would go from place to place and hold preaching services, baptisms and marriages. One of the famous Arbor churches in our area is the church located at Tanglewood Park. The old church located on that property is an old arbor church, over the years as the property changed hands the church was abandoned. There are many arbor churches located around the Winston-Salem area that are still in existence today. Camp meetings were also held at Balls Creek Camp Ground which still is in existence and still has a time of camp meeting, and families go and camp out and go to extended preaching and Bible study times.

These are left over from the two times of Revival in the American colonies. They were called the 1st and 2nd Great Revivals. These periods help spread Christianity westward and gave rise to many of our churches today. The 2nd Great Revival period ended in the 1850's. Rev. Thomas Cooke and Francis Asbury traveled all up and down the colonies and preached at various places which first began the development of the Methodist Church in the American Colonies. The Methodist church grew so fast that at one time it was the largest Protestant church in America until the 1920's, when another denomination overtook the Methodist.
